RUSHBEARING FESTIVAL Thanks to everyone who supported the festival and made it a success. See below what we made in previous years – with full results next week.

Bar profits have decreased over the specified years. While there was only a slight drop of £18.36 from 2017 to 2018, the decrease from 2018 to 2022 was more significant, totalling £115.54. This sharp decline in 2022 is due having extra stock to be used in October of that year. The funds raised for SVP showed growth from 2017 to 2018 with an increase of £33.90. However, there was a slight decline of £12.50 from 2018 to 2022. While this is not as large as the drop in bar profits, it may still be of concern and could be indicative of broader trends or issues that affected fundraising during these years. The Ladies Group had the highest contributions among the categories listed. Their contribution increased substantially by £143.01 from 2017 to 2018. However, the year 2022 saw a decrease to at least £500.00. So the exact drop is at least £200.01. The Rushbearing Festival, over the years detailed in this report, has demonstrated fluctuating financial outcomes. The festival saw no activities in 2019 and 2020, and its return in 2022 brought declines in all three categories when compared to previous active years. This hiatus and the subsequent decline in 2022 can be attributed to numerous challenges faced in restarting the event, from re-engaging the community to adapting to new circumstances. Looking forward, there is optimism and hope that the 2023 Rushbearing Festival will rebound and be a prosperous year, as the community reacquaints itself with this cherished tradition.

ON SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 3RD, we will gather in reverence and joy to mark the 70th anniversary of the original school's opening in 1953. The Holy Mass, a cornerstone of our faith, will be celebrated with the special intention of commemorating the auspicious day of August 31, 1953, when the doors of the school were first opened in the church house. This event is not just a testament to the enduring legacy of Catholic education but a heartfelt tribute to all who attended, walked its corridors, and became part of its rich history. After the Mass, in the spirit of community and shared memories, everyone is cordially invited for coffee and tea, accompanied by a special display of photographs capturing poignant moments from the school's first decade. It's a unique opportunity for all to reminisce, reconnect, and celebrate the institution that has shaped so many lives. The hall will be open to guests from 11-3pm, and all are welcome.

MASS ATTENDANCE 2018 - 2023

5168 people attended Mass (Jan – Dec 2020) |5979 people attended Mass (Jan – Dec 2021) 9392 people attended Mass (Jan – Dec 2022) |August 2023, Mass attendance figures stand at **7584**

- 1. 2020 (Jan Dec): The Mass attendance figure for the entire year of 2020 was 5,168 attendees.
- 2. 2021 (Jan Dec): In 2021, the Mass saw an increase in attendance with a total of 5,979 attendees, marking a growth of approximately 15.7% compared to 2020.
- 3. 2022 (Jan Dec): There was a significant increase in Mass attendance in 2022, with a total of 9,392 attendees. This represents a growth of approximately 57.1% compared to 2021.
- 4. 2023 (Jan Aug): As of August 2023, the Mass attendance figures are 7,584. If we project this rate for the entire year (considering the same monthly attendance rate for the remaining months), the estimated total would be approximately **11,376** attendees. This would represent an estimated growth of 21.1% compared to 2022, assuming the same attendance pattern continues for the rest of the year.
- There has been a consistent upward trend in Mass attendance from 2020 to 2023.
- The largest year-on-year growth was observed between 2021 and 2022, with an increase of 57.1%.
- Even though the data for the full year of 2023 is not available, if the trend continues, the expected attendance will surpass the figures of 2022. Just keep coming to Mass.

HOLY SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM A date and time for your child's Baptism can be provisionally given once you have completed the parish form and established a relationship with the parish. The choice of godparents is important. A godparent is a role model for your child by living a fully Christian life, there are usually two godparents. Godparents must be at least 16yrs of age, practising Catholics and should have received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. Parents are responsible for instructing and forming their children in both the teaching and practice of the Catholic faith. Although Catholic schools exist to help parents in this regard, they are not a substitute for it. The best instruction that you can give your child is through commitment to the Mass. As you make this request for your child, it should also be a reality in your own life. If after reading this information you feel ready to present, your child to the Church for Baptism please see Fr Larkin after Mass for Pre-Baptism form.
