“AD ORIENTEM” What Does the Church Say About *Ad Orientem*?

Contrary to what many think, *ad orientem* celebration has never been forbidden by the Church. In fact, the current Roman Missal (used for the Ordinary Form of the Mass) quietly assumes it. The rubrics (instructions) even note when the priest is to “turn to the people,” suggesting that he is not always facing them. Popes and liturgists have spoken with love about this tradition. Pope Benedict XVI wrote, “Looking at the priest has no importance. What matters is looking together at the Lord.” Cardinal Robert Sarah, former Prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship, encouraged parishes to consider this posture, saying it beautifully expresses “the primacy of God and the eschatological horizon of the liturgy.”

Readings at Mass

First reading Genesis 18:1-10a

In those days: The Lord appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them and bowed himself to the earth and said, 'O Lord, if I have found favour in your sight, do not pass by your servant. Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree, while I bring a morsel of bread, that you may refresh yourselves, and after that you may pass on — since you have come to your servant.' So they said, 'Do as you have said.' And Abraham went quickly into the tent to Sarah and said, 'Quick! Three measures of fine flour! Knead it, and make cakes.' And Abraham ran to the herd and took a calf, tender and good, and gave it to a young man, who prepared it quickly. Then he took curds and milk, and the calf that he had prepared, and set it before them. And he stood by them under the tree while they ate. They said to him, 'Where is Sarah your wife?' And he said, 'She is in the tent.' The Lord said, 'I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife shall have a son.'
